

## Greenhouse Gas Leadership Forum

**Background and Purpose:** The US EPA has promulgated a Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Reporting rule, which requires facilities which emit over threshold quantities of GHGs to collect and report annual emissions data. Electronics manufacturing facilities filed their first emissions reports in accordance with Subpart I of the GHG Reporting rule last year. EPA is revising the industry's reporting requirements and a final rule is anticipated in the second half of 2013. The semiconductor industry uses GHGs in manufacturing processes, and most facilities will fall under the compliance requirements of this rule. Collection of inventory and emission data is complicated and will require companies to expend additional resources to ensure compliance. Additionally, GHG emissions from process and combustion sources were added to Title V permitting requirements and semiconductor facilities may now require Title V permits as major sources.

The purpose of this forum is to bring together electronic industry compliance specialists, management, consultants and others to discuss key aspects of the GHG reporting rule and Title V permitting, compliance strategies and challenges.
