If the Sponsor is unable to provide verification documentation, the CIH/CAIH will use an Attendance Verification Form which must be signed by the Sponsor for each CIH/CAIH on each day of the Activity.

For conferences physically attended by an out-of-town CIH/CAIH, the Sponsor does not need to provide participation verification. This is a responsibility of the CIH/CAIH. Acceptable verification methods are provided in the CM Handbook, available to all CIH/CAIHs.
