October 17 - 20 – Austin Airport Hilton*

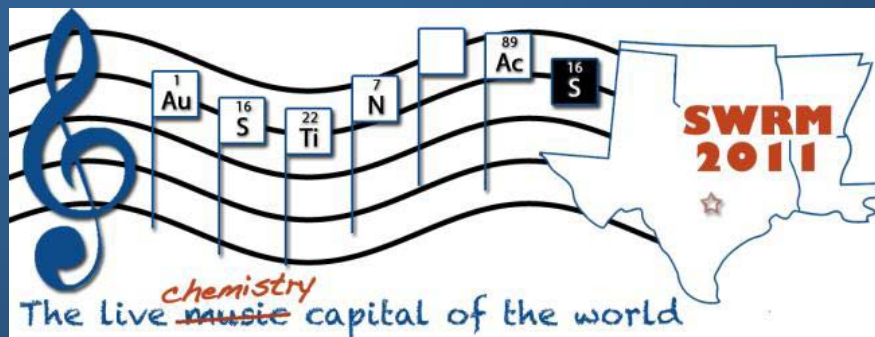

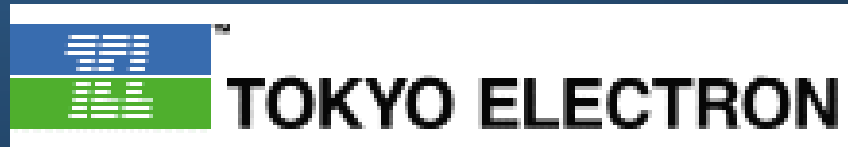
