Student Poster Competition

In lieu of the traditional scholarship program, for the 34th Annual International High Technology Environment, Safety and Health Conference, SESHAs will be holding a Student Poster Competition.

Who Should Enter

Any full-time students actively working towards an undergraduate or graduate level college degree in ESH.

What to Submit

Entrants may choose to enter their poster one of the many categories including but not limited to: global chemical regulations, emission or chemical models to avoid animal testing, emerging EHS, green technologies, design for EHS, ergonomics, sustainability, industrial hygiene monitoring techniques, restriction of hazardous substances and alternative solutions, product lifecycle and take back programs, global harmonization system (GHS), etc.

Review Process

The SESHAs Academic committee will review the posters and abstracts. Accepted posters will be listed in the 2012 SESHAs eJournal and SESHAs website. The top three posters will receive a cash prize, a plaque, and a one-year SESHAs membership.

Key Dates:

February 10, 2012	Submittal of poster applications and abstract
February 24, 2012	Students will receive acceptance notification
March 30, 2012	Submittal of technical content of poster

Poster sessions will be held the week of April 9th, 2012 at Dolce Hayes Mansion in San Jose, CA

Student Poster Process

1. The student must submit a typed SESHAs poster application and abstract by the close of business on **February 10, 2012** or sooner.
2. Assistance from SESHAs members is available. See LinkedIn or SESHAs website for contacts.
3. The SESHAs Academic Committee will review each poster application and abstract. All students can present their posters at the 2012 Annual Symposium.
4. The Academic Committee will select the top three (3) posters.
5. Each student who presents a poster will receive a complimentary shared housing at the conference hotel.
6. The top three posters will be awarded cash prizes and plaques for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. In addition, the winners will have their posters published by SESHAs in its online eJournal.
7. The top three posters will receive a cash award of \$1,000.
8. Each poster winner must be in good standing for scholarship eligibility. Annual student membership dues are \$25.
